High School Seniors are graduating. School is ending. With full orchestra and organ, the Chancel Choir has concluded its season with a superlative concert. The Joyful Ringers have stored their bells away for a September day. And the PYF Mission Trip and Vacation Bible School are on the horizon. Yes, we are slipping into summer mode at GCC. For the next three months our pews will be less populated on Sunday mornings and life will be simpler and more relaxed around the church.

But what a year it has been! We have celebrated our 75th Anniversary in grand style. Beginning with the music of the Decades of GCC back in April of 2016 (1940's, 1950's, 1960's, 1970's, 1980's, 1990's, 2000's, and 2010's) we celebrated with special displays, a Festival Anniversary Service, a service honoring our Pastor Emeritus, Rev. Robert Warskow, a commissioned work for organ by noted composer **Paul Ayres** based on Somewhere Over the Rainbow, a commissioned anthem and a commissioned hymn by our friend **Paul Leddington Wright**, a weekend when we were blessed by the presence of the United Church of Christ's General Minister and President, the Rev. Dr. John Dorhauer and his wife Mimi...and a landmark concert featuring Alexandre Guilmant's Organ Symphony and Felix Mendelssohn's Lobegesang (Song of Praise). What a joy it has been to praise God for the history and the ministry of Glenview Community Church.

In this Diamond Jubilee year, we have also concluded our *Forward in Faith* Capital Campaign to which you have committed over \$3.8 million to repair, renovate and renew our heavily used and well-worn church building. Even adjusted for infla-

tion, this is the largest stewardship effort in GCC's history! Now the **Construction Committee** is working diligently to invest this resoundingly successful campaign in GCC's future, bringing as much of Phase I of the Master Plan that we developed with the help of **The Kubala Washatko Architects** to fruition as is financially possible. Stay tuned as the Construction Committee shares its progress toward securing our *Infrastructure*, increasing *Accessibility*, and enhancing *Community* in and through our church's building so that it best enables and supports our contemporary ministry.

But that's not all! We have approved and launched the work of our **Governance** Task Force that restructures GCC, shifting its focus away from management and toward ministry...we have valiantly and persistently sought and secured the stewardship support we need for our Message, Ministries and Mission in 2017...we have rejoiced at the marriage of the Rev. Elizabeth Hartung Ciccolini and Bob Mc-**Gee**...and we have grown in the depth of our spiritual walk with our God through the **Spiritual Life Teams** brought to us and led by the Rev. Bobbie McKay, Ph.D. Whew! Just making this list can feel exhausting, but it's truly exhilarating!

What this list witnesses to is that, even in a milestone anniversary year, GCC is not sitting still and resting on its laurels. Instead, we are moving forward in our journey to become ever more faithfully *A House for ALL God's People*. And that's happening because of you! How blessed we are that individuals and families in and around Glenview are intentionally choosing a faith community that is committed to diversity and inclusivity....that we are growing in

Join us on June 21 at 7:00 p.m. in the Chapel for a program led by Pauline Viviano titled, **Paul's Theology—Relevant or Obsolete?**Paul of Tarsus was a controversial character in his own day and remains so today. He is acknowledged by some as the greatest Christian theologian, but for others he is to be condemned for distorting the gospel. By focusing on Paul's epistles to the Romans and to the Corinthians we will explore the theological and practical sides of Paul's understanding of salvation as achieved in Jesus' death and resurrection and consider whether Paul's theology continues to have meaning for us today.
