

"Shi'ite and Iranian Spirituality" will be presented by Ahmad Sadri. Join him for an unprecedented encounter with the deepest spiritual roots of Iranian culture and Shi'ite religion. Almad will draw upon his new translation of the Persian Book of Kings, the Persianate equivalent of the lliad and the Odyssey. Longer than those two Greek classics put together, the opus was completed one thousand and two years ago, after thirty years of labor by the Persian poet Ferdowsi.
